





CHILDCARE INITIATIVE WORKGROUP GOALS

GOAL ONE:

Childcare availability in Tomah will expand by 20% by the end of 2026 through growing new collaborations.

This will require Tomah to add 66 new childcare slots and preserve its existing 330 slots.

ACTIONS REQUIRED TO MEET GOAL:

IN THE NEXT 3 MONTHS...

-Identify local businesses interested in supporting new childcare programs and engage them in collaborations to grow childcare availability

OVER THE NEXT YEAR...

-Expand the childcare workforce

- Grow the school to work program at Tomah High School
- Better illustrate the childcare career ladder from assistant teacher to lead teacher to center director/childcare business owner
- Ensure livable, sustainable wages for childcare workers that are competitive and attractive
- Partner with Western Technical College to educate more childcare workers

-Provide entrepreneurship support for individuals interested in starting childcare businesses

• Utilize existing small business development resources such as SBDC, SBA, SCORE, WWBIC, etc.

GOAL TWO:

Support for all existing family and group childcare providers in Tomah will increase in order to ensure local providers are sustainable over the long term.

ACTIONS REQUIRED TO MEET GOAL:

- Host a Childcare Provider Appreciation Night
- Conduct outreach to unregulated providers and work to build relationships with them to learn about their needs, barriers, etc.
- Survey providers to better understand their business costs such as food, supplies, insurance, training, certification/credentials, etc.
- Conduct asset mapping exercise of engaged employers to determine what assets they could leverage to support childcare providers, such as food, buildings, volunteer labor, skills in the trades, etc.

- Banks Banks are needed to help finance family childcare providers looking to buy homes
- Landlords Landlords that are willing to allow family childcare providers to operate out of their rentals are needed
